Residential Trash

Residential trash and recycling pick up is provided to single family residential households and limited multi-family units with the exception of apartment complexes. The City of Greenwood Village contracts with Republic Services to provide residential household trash pick up each week. Please bag all trash and place in a closed container to protect it from the weather, insects and animals.

TRASH TIPS

- ◆ Trash trucks may come at different times each week. Have your trash curbside by 7:00 a.m. the day of your pick up to guarantee timely trash collection.
- ◆ Please report any service issues to Public Works within 24 hours of your pick up day.
- ◆ Two trucks will come through your neighborhood on your scheduled day, one for trash and another for recyclables.
- ◆ Trash and recycling bundles should weigh no more than 50 pounds.
- ◆ For a fee of \$5.00 per month, Republic can provide a "carry out" service. This service is free to customers who have qualified for the temporary or permanent disabilities under the American Disabilities Act.
- ◆ Make sure children's toys are not placed near curbside trash.

Residential Hazardous & Electronic Waste

Household hazardous waste should not be placed with your household trash. The City of Greenwood Village has contracted with At Your Door Special Collection, a Waste Management Company, for residential hazardous and electronic waste pick up. To arrange for a free pickup, please call 800.449.7587.

Large Item Pick Ups

In order to take a personal role in the improvement of our environment, The City of Greenwood Village offers a **Large Item** pick up to its residents.

Large or odd size items such as furniture may be placed along the curb in the street out of the way of pedestrians and traffic.

A list of acceptable items for this service is on our website. Residents are responsible for the removal of unacceptable items.

Contractor generated trash will not be picked up. The contractor is responsible for removing those items.

Large item pick ups are done every week Monday thru Friday, weather permitting.

Please call Public Works at 303.708.6100 to schedule a large item pickup before placing your items curbside.

Residential Recycling

Single Stream Recycling provides that all recyclables can be combined into one container without the need to separate. There is no additional cost for recycling services. Recycling is provided every other week on the same day as your trash service. Service includes one 95 gallon container to each single family residential household. Please do not put recyclables in trash bags. Below is a list of acceptable items.

RECYCLING TIPS

- ◆ Paper/Cardboard - newspapers, inserts, magazines, junk mail, white and colored paper, posters, phonebooks and cereal boxes without the plastic insert. Cardboard can be no larger than 3' x 3'.
- ◆ Aluminum/Glass/Plastic - beverage cans, pet food cans, glass bottles, jars and plastic bottles #1-#7. You may leave labels on but please remove the lids and rinse.

Republic Services Trash and Recycling Collection

Listed below are the Holidays that will affect the normal collection schedule. If your trash day falls on or after a holiday (that same week), your pickup will be one day later. Service will **not** be delayed if the holiday falls on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday. (On a normal schedule, the City does NOT have trash and recycling service on Friday.)

Holidays that affect 2016 collection schedule:

Memorial Day, Monday May 30

Labor Day, Monday September 5

Independence Day, Monday July 4

Thanksgiving Day, Thursday November 24
