Marjorie Perry Nature Preserve is home to a wide variety of mammals, namely coyote, red fox, raccoon, skunk, cottontail rabbit, muskrat, deer mouse, brown bat and squirrel. Generally, the best time to see wildlife is in the early morning or late afternoon. Nocturnal animals such as skunk and raccoons are rarely seen during the daylight hours, but you can identify their tracks in fresh mud or around ponds and lakes.






Striped Skunk
