The following are the anticipated traffic impacts for the week of Jan. 14:

## I-25

- No lane restrictions at this time

## Arapahoe Road

- 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, Monday, Jan. 15 through Friday, Jan. 19
  - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions between Uinta /Greenwood Plaza Boulevard and Clinton Court for painting and sign installation

## Yosemite Street

- 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, Monday, Jan. 15 through Friday, Jan. 19
  - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions between Peakview Avenue and Xanthia Street for landscaping and roadway work

## Boston/Clinton Street

- 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, Monday, Jan. 15 through Friday, Jan. 19
  - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions from Southtech Drive to just south of Arapahoe Road for sidewalk, curb/gutter and electrical work

The I-25 and Arapahoe Interchange Reconstruction project team reminds you to adhere to the reduced speed limits of 55 mph on I-25 and 40 mph on Arapahoe Road, in the work zone. Please avoid distractions and watch for signage to guide you through the construction area.

Project Information: This \$66 million Responsible Acceleration of Maintenance (RAMP) Project includes building an additional lane along westbound Arapahoe Road from Yosemite Street to Greenwood Plaza Boulevard, providing three left turn lanes from the I-25 off-ramps, realigning the frontage road in the northeast quadrant of the interchange, building noise walls near the Arapahoe Road and Yosemite Street intersection and widening Yosemite Street from Yosemite Circle on the north to Xanthia Street on the south. This project is designed to reduce congestion and improve traffic operations and safety. The project has reached substantial completion; however, intermittent lane restrictions will be required through spring 2018 to complete landscaping and various punch list (touch-up) items.
