CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

I-25 and Arapahoe Interchange Reconstruction project Weekly Traveler Alert - Week of October 15

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) continues reconstruction of the I-25 and Arapahoe Road interchange. I-25 and Arapahoe Road Interchange Reconstruction project limits are Belleview Avenue to County Line Road on I-25 and Dayton to Quebec streets on Arapahoe Road. Keep in mind that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

The following are the anticipated traffic impacts for the week of Oct. 15:

I-25

- **8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. nightly, Monday, Oct. 16 through Thursday, Oct. 19**
 - Southbound and northbound I-25 left and right lane restrictions between Orchard and Dry Creek roads beginning at 8 p.m., with only one lane open at 10 p.m. for final lane striping
 - Intermittent northbound and southbound I-25 off-and on- ramp closures are also planned. Use Orchard or Dry Creek roads as alternate routes

Arapahoe Road

- **8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, Monday, Oct. 16 through Friday, Oct. 20**
 - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions between Uinta /Greenwood Plaza Boulevard and Clinton Court for median and roadway construction

Yosemite Street

- **8:30 a.m., Friday, Oct. 13 through 5:30 a.m., Monday, Oct. 16**
 - Restrictions at the Yosemite Street/Circle intersection for driveway reconstruction. Southbound/northbound through traffic on Yosemite Street maintained; eastbound/westbound through traffic restricted
 - Arapahoe Marketplace business access maintained via Arapahoe Road and Greenwood Plaza Boulevard

- Other business access maintained from Yosemite Circle/Court

- **8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, Monday, Oct. 16 through Friday, Oct. 20**
 - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions between Peakview Avenue and Xanthia Street for median and roadway construction

Boston/Clinton Street

- **8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, Monday, Oct. 16 through Friday, Oct. 20**
 - Right and left lane restrictions in both directions from Southtech Drive to just south of Arapahoe Road for median and roadway construction

The I-25 and Arapahoe Interchange Reconstruction project team reminds you to adhere to the reduced speed limits of 55 mph on I-25 and 40 mph on Arapahoe Road, in the work zone. Please avoid distractions and watch for signage to guide you through the construction area.

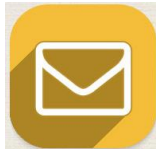
Project Information: This \$66 million Responsible Acceleration of Maintenance (RAMP) Project includes building an additional lane along westbound Arapahoe Road from Yosemite Street to Greenwood Plaza Boulevard, providing three left turn lanes from the I-25 off-ramps, realigning the frontage road in the northeast quadrant of the interchange, building noise walls near the Arapahoe Road and Yosemite Street intersection and widening Yosemite Street from Yosemite Circle on the north to Xanthia Street on the south. This project is designed to reduce congestion and improve traffic operations and safety. Substantial completion is slated for summer 2018.
