Park Use Guidelines for Outside Fitness Providers

The Department of Parks, Trails and Recreation assures the provision of personal enjoyment and personal development through high quality parks, trails, open spaces, recreation and arts programs and community events for Greenwood Village. We recognize the role that outside fitness providers' play in assisting our citizens in their journey for a healthy lifestyle and welcome the use of our parks and trails to conduct fitness instruction.

In order to maintain a pleasant and safe park experience for all users, staff has developed the following guidelines. All outside fitness providers should:

- Maintain a national personal trainer or group fitness certification from a National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCAA) recognized organization. This would include but is not limited to the following organizations:
 - American Council on Exercise (ACE)
 - National Strength and Conditioning Association (NSCA)
 - American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM)
 - National Academy of Sports Medicine (NASM)
- Maintain liability insurance; Requirement: General liability coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 naming the City of Greenwood Village as an additional insured.
- Maintain a City of Greenwood Village Business license- Can be obtained at City Hall Finance Department located at 6060 South Quebec Street or <https://co-greenwoodvillage2.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/12026>
- Permitted use will have priority for use of park space (Season long permits are required for youth sport agencies and have first priority on all fields in Greenwood Village)
- Remove all trash from exercise areas at the conclusion of each session
- Remove all temporary supplies (cones, ropes, signs and other training equipment) from the park site at the conclusion of each training session
- Change area of each exercise session to ensure grass areas are not overused
- Any trail in Greenwood Village can be accessed by fitness providers; however, the trails are not-exclusive to fitness providers and are subject to the ***Greenwood Village Ordinance 8.24.030. Any noise that can be heard beyond a residential property line is prohibited.***

The following park areas are available to the fitness providers. Please note that areas near homes are not conducive to the ***Greenwood Village Ordinance 8.24.030. Any noise that can be heard beyond a residential property line is prohibited.***

 - Westlands Park (5701 South Quebec Street)
 - Village Greens Park (9301 East Union Avenue)
 - Tommy Davis Park (9200 East Orchard Road)
 - Silo Park (9300 East Orchard Road)
 - William McKinley Carson Park (6060 South Quebec Street)
