

GREENWOOD VILLAGE PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

The park use rules and regulations as established by the City Council shall be followed.

1. Shelters, pavilions and fields can be permitted from 8 am – dusk Monday through Saturday and from 10 am to dusk Sundays and Holidays. Only single day Sunday permits will be issued, no consecutive Sunday permits allowed. EXCEPTION: Curtis Park can not be reserved until 1 pm on Sundays.
2. Tents, booths, awnings, canopies, and grills etc. are prohibited without the consent of Greenwood Village staff.
3. Inflatable amusements are prohibited without the consent of Village staff. Specific site location of inflatable will be determined by Greenwood Village staff.
4. Field markings are not allowed by user groups without the consent of Village staff.
5. Cancellation fees: Cancellation within two weeks will result in a 10% rental fee charge
Exception: Weather: Village will work with permit holder to reschedule date or issue a full refund.
6. No field shall be played upon when wet enough to cause damage to the field. Check the weather line after 4 pm on Fridays for Saturday closures. Weather line 303-486-5770
7. Spectators and players shall not trespass onto private property bordering the parks.
8. Upon completion of permitted use, the area shall be restored to a litter free condition.
9. Greenwood Village has the right to access any individual or organization responsible for any undue damage or abuse to the park. Repair or cleanup beyond normal use will be billed to applicant based on cost of service.
10. Greenwood Village parks are patrolled by local law enforcement and all other applicable rules and regulations to include City ordinances will be enforced.

GREENWOOD VILLAGE ORDINANCES

12.32.040. Park lands shall be open from dawn until dusk, and closed dusk until dawn. (City sponsored events excluded.)

12.32.050. Resident Priority. Applicants for resident events may apply for a single date permit 60 days before applicants for non-resident events per seasonal permitting schedule.

12.32.060. Any group of thirty or more persons who wish to use park lands for any purpose shall first obtain a permit. Groups of less than thirty may also reserve shelters or other facilities by obtaining a permit.

12.33.030. No commercial concessions shall be operated on park premises. (Exception: Youth tournaments approved by PTR Department)

12.32.100. Alcoholic beverages containing more than 3.2 alcohol by weight prohibited. (Exception: Special Occasion Alcohol Permit)

12.32.100. No glass containers. (Exception: Special Occasion Alcohol Permit)

12.32.100. No fires, except in enclosed grills.

12.32.070. Motorized vehicles are prohibited on any City park land, which includes bike paths and trails. Unloading or loading supplies must be in the roadway, parking lot or adjacent to sidewalk areas.

8.24.030. Any amplification must be duly noted on permit request and the Greenwood Village noise ordinance will be strictly enforced. Any noise that can be heard beyond a residential property line is prohibited.

A lightning prediction device has been installed at Curtis, Village Greens, Tommy Davis, Silo and Westlands Parks. At the first horn blast, please seek shelter until the all clear horn has been sounded.
