

For Immediate Release



On August 13, 2018, at 3:30 a.m., the Greenwood Village Police Department was called to the La Quinta North at 9009 E. Arapahoe Road. The initial call was of a male subject, naked and running through the hallways screaming and yelling. Once officers were on scene, the male subject barricaded himself inside his hotel room. Officers attempted communications with the male for several hours. At about 6:00 a.m., the male subject began throwing items from the fourth-floor hotel room window out into the parking lot. The male threw all furniture, fixtures and decorations out of the window and eventually he tore out the toilet, throwing that out the window as well. Incident Command had already turned off the water to the hotel, but a tremendous amount of water damage was done due to the residual water in the pipes. Officers continued to negotiate with the male for many hours. At 4:25 p.m., officers breached the hotel room door, and entered with a K-9 Unit. The K-9 contacted the subject, and officers were able to safely take the male in to custody. The male was transported to a local hospital for medical evaluation and will be held on a warrant filed by the Greenwood Village Police Department through the 18th Judicial District Attorney's Office.
