 - 2) Products, completed operations: two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00).
 - 3) Personal and advertising injury: one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
 - 4) Each occurrence: one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

Proof of current Workers' Compensation and General Liability insurance coverage shall include the name of the business, name of the insurance company, policy number, effective and expiration dates, and a statement naming the City of Greenwood Village as the certificate holder. Proof of coverage may be sent by mail or email.

Note: Workers' Compensation coverage is required if the business has any employees. **The expiration of any insurance coverage and/or the application will render your license inactive.**

<input type="checkbox"/>	Level B:	Residential \$200 Authorizes work with respect to detached single family residential buildings and alterations thereto, and work authorized under Levels C & D licenses.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Level C:	Specialized \$100 Authorizes work with respect to solar or satellite installations, swimming pools, and tennis courts.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Level D:	Individual Trade \$50 Authorizes work with respect to roofing, framing, fences, retaining walls, sprinkler irrigation, landscaping, mechanical, signs, etc., and single trades when not set forth for higher level licenses. Specify Trade:
