Dear Residents and Businesses of Greenwood Village,

The health and safety of the Greenwood Village community is our highest priority. We are all concerned about the spread of COVID-19 and we want to minimize the likelihood that it spreads in our community. As we continue to monitor this rapidly evolving pandemic, Village staff and I are in constant contact with federal, state and local agencies to share resources and information. At the local level, Greenwood Village has partnered with Arapahoe County and its' jurisdictions to combat COVID-19, through the formation of a County Wide Incident Emergency Management Command System, which includes an array of agencies, law enforcement, and key personnel from every city.

As we work together to find ways to help one another stay safe and healthy, City Manager John Jackson and I have taken the following steps, focusing on the health and well-being of our residents, businesses, visitors, and Village employees. Please note the information and dates provided herein may be updated, as we respond accordingly to protect the public and our Village employees' health.

Informational Points

- Essential services continue to be provided including police services, trash, recycling, large item pickup, snow removal, park maintenance, building permits and inspections. - City facilities are limited to only employees until at least March 30. This includes, but is not limited to, public business and activities at City Hall (including Municipal Court) and our Maintenance Facility. Please note the Curtis Center for the Arts is temporarily closed.
- All recreational events, programs, and classes have been cancelled through April 12. Sadly, this includes the Branch and Poppy's Eggstravaganza that was scheduled for April 9th. We will issue refunds for all cancelled programs, activities and classes that are affected by the safety guidelines.
