Update on Cherry Creek Campus Circulation Study - 2022 Projects

Staff presented an update of the Cherry Creek Circulation Study and 2022 projects related to the outcome of the study. The study was completed in 2021 to evaluate existing conditions and identify alternatives to reduce congestion and improve safety in the vicinity of the Cherry Creek campus. The study identified 34 improvements for consideration by both the Village and the Cherry Creek School District. The improvements were organized into three general categories: Infrastructure Alternatives, on-Campus Improvements, and Low-Cost Safety Improvements.

A total of 15 infrastructure improvements were identified for Dayton Street as the corridor experiences the majority of the congestion.

The On-Campus Improvements identified a mix of technology and infrastructure alternatives that can be implemented on the campus itself to accommodate buses and the pick-up/drop-off traffic.

In 2022, the intersection of Union Avenue and Dayton Street has been identified as a Capital Improvement Project to include infrastructure and low-cost safety improvements. Of the 34 alternatives identified in the study, seven alternatives were identified for this intersection. The remaining six alternatives for the intersection will be evaluated for feasibility and design.

Additionally, the recommended phased signal timing upgrades will be implemented in 2022. The upgraded signal system will result in potential operational improvements.

Staff is continuing outreach with the Cherry Creek School District to discuss the projects for 2022 and next steps.

- City Council approved a resolution granting a new Hotel & Restaurant Liquor License for Steady Bones Ventures, LLC dba Spitz Mediterranean Street Food at 8181 East Arapahoe Road, Suite E. They anticipate opening in May 2022.

Special Use Permit

- City Council approved a Special Use Permit (SUP) for Paw School, a "kennel" and dog training facility located at 6813 S. Dayton Street in the Shops of Greenwood Village.

Paw School will be occupying nearly 6,000 square feet for indoor training activities. There will be no outdoor training nor overnight boarding.

The Planning & Zoning Commission reviewed the proposal in February and recommended approval of the SUP to City Council.

Paw School anticipates opening in the summer of 2022.
