

For Immediate Release



On June 16, 2022, at approximately 12:08 PM, the Greenwood Village Police Department responded to reports of a subject appearing disoriented and in distress on the Yosemite Street overpass to I-25. Responding officers began negotiating with the subject who appeared to be in crisis. Out of concern for motorists on I-25, both the north and southbound lanes of travel were shut down until the situation was resolved.

After approximately 70 minutes of negotiations, the subject was safely taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for observation. The interstate was reopened to traffic shortly thereafter.
