COUNCIL MEETING

Council takes action at Regular Meetings which are open to the public for in-person attendance and also audio-streamed live via the Village's website. Recent actions include:

Ordinances and Resolutions

- Council adopted **Ordinance No. 07-22** on second and final reading, amending section 16-22-130 of the Greenwood Village Municipal Code regulating home occupations to prohibit the commercial sales of firearms in residential areas in conjunction with any home-based business. The ordinance does not prohibit occasional private sales of firearms from a residence, nor can zoning changes be applied retroactively, which means that any Federal Firearm License (FFL) dealer business currently operating will become a legal non-conforming use.

Ordinances and Resolutions - Continued

(Ordinance No. 07-22) The ordinance will be effective on July 18.

- Council approved [Ordinance No. 08-22](#) (1st Reading), amending Section 16-2-120 of the Greenwood Village Municipal Code Regarding Variance Criteria. The ordinance removes the requirement that the Board of Adjustments and Appeals find that a variance request is not a grant of special privilege.
- Council approved [Ordinance No. 09-22](#) (1st Reading) amending Section 4-10-120 of the Greenwood Village Municipal Code regarding publication prior to disposition of unclaimed property. This change modifies the notice requirements to allow the Police Department staff to utilize web-based technology to post a running up-to-date listing of all unclaimed property on the City's website rather than publish a static list in a newspaper.
- Council approved [Resolution No. 29-22](#) changing the City of Greenwood Village Beer and Liquor Regulations regarding requirements to register managers due to the recent adoption of State House Bill 22-1415.

New Business

- Council passed a motion to authorize the Mayor to execute an [intergovernmental agreement with Arapahoe County](#) to resurface all of the High Line Canal Trail within Greenwood Village.
- Council passed separate motions to authorize the Mayor to execute amendments to the intergovernmental agreements with [Arapahoe County](#) and the [City of Centennial](#) to share the increased cost of improvements to the High Line Canal trail crossing on Orchard Road west of University Boulevard. The improvements will add bump-outs to the trail crossing to improve the visibility of pedestrians crossing Orchard Road west of Curtis Park.
