STUDY SESSION

Study Sessions are set aside for Council to have discussions and gather information and study issues more in depth before taking any actions at a Regular Meeting. Recent discussions include:

Continued Discussion of Employee Compensation and Benefits

Council held a discussion regarding [employee compensation and benefits](#) for 2023. Council discussed a new compensation philosophy for the general employees during the June 20 and August 1 Study Sessions. The consensus of Council was to implement the new philosophy change, effective retroactively on July 1, 2022 and prepare the 2023 budget under the new compensation philosophy.

Discussion of Updates to Chapter 16 - Land Development Code Definitions and Procedures

Council discussed proposed changes to the [Land Development Code definitions and procedures](#). The purpose of the discussion was a clean up effort to clarify items in the Land Development Code. Council agreed that a committee should be formed to further study the proposed changes in depth and return at a future Study Session.

COUNCIL MEETING

Council takes action at Regular Meetings which are open to the public for in-person attendance and also [audio-streamed live via the Village's website](#). Recent actions include:

Ordinances

- Council adopted on second reading [Ordinance No. 10-22](#): An Ordinance Adopting a Second Amended Budget and Providing for the Supplemental Appropriation of Money for the Various Funds, Departments, Offices, and Agencies of the City of Greenwood Village, Colorado, for the 2022 Fiscal Year. The amendment modifies the 2022 budget to appropriate funds for a number of projects that have changed since the adoption of the 2022 budget. The ordinance also recognizes additional revenue and contribution matches required by the Village for certain projects.

New Business

- Council authorized the Mayor to Execute the [Amended and Restated 2009 Intergovernmental Agreement](#) regarding public improvements at Village Town Center. The amendment eliminates the Village's original responsibility to build and maintain streetscape improvements in the Village Town Center inner circle in exchange for a \$1 million contribution toward the construction of a park within the circle, and the elimination of the requirement to participate financially in ongoing maintenance. The Greenwood Consolidated Metropolitan District will retain ownership of the park and be responsible for reservations and programming. The Fiddlers Business Improvement District is responsible for designing and constructing the park improvements and will split the cost of maintenance with the Metro District.
