STUDY SESSION

Study Sessions are set aside for Council to have discussions and gather information and study issues more in depth before taking any actions at a Regular Meeting. Residents are invited to hear the discussions in-person or listen online via the [Village's live online audio-stream](#), but are not allowed to participate in Study Session. Recent discussions include:

Discussion Regarding Residential Composting

Council discussed options for residential composting services following requests from residents for these services. Staff developed a list of options for Council to consider, including providing the service to all households, by sign-up only, selecting a preferred provider through an RFP process, or providing information for residents on local composting companies via the City website and other communication.

Council directed staff to engage residents on the topic to gauge a level of interest on the topic via the City's online feedback portal, Village Voices, and provide education to residents regarding the benefits of composting and potential future options. Staff will also determine whether revenues from the new statewide plastic bag fees might be sufficient to support a City composting program, ask local composting providers how many GV residents they are currently serving, and ask other local agencies about participation in their composting programs.

STUDY SESSION - CONT.

Update from the Land Development Code Committee

Staff provided an overview of draft ordinances from the Land Development Code (LDC) Committee proposing changes to definitions including the location of residential fences, amend RV and utility trailer parking rules, and amend the allowed uses of accessory buildings in residential areas. Council recommended the LDC bring forward these changes to City Council via ordinance.
