STUDY SESSION

Study Sessions are set aside for Council to have discussions and gather information and study issues more in depth before taking any actions at a Regular Meeting. Residents are invited to hear the discussions in-person or listen online via the [Village's live online audio-stream](#), but are not allowed to participate in Study Session. Recent discussions include:

Presentation Regarding Micromobility Pilot for Greenwood Consolidated and Goldsmith Metropolitan Districts

Representatives from both districts presented a micromobility pilot which would be in partnership with Spin. The pilot is based on a similar deployment in Meridian Metropolitan District near I-25 and Lincoln Avenue in Douglas County.

Discussion of Management of e-Bikes and e-Scooters

Staff recommended a set of regulations to manage e-bikes and e-scooters in Greenwood Village. Council requested adjustments to the proposed regulations, which would be presented at a future study session.
